ABOUT COLLEGE

Shri Dadapatil Rajale Educational Institute's Dadapatil Rajale Arts, Science and Commerce College was founded in 1991 by Honourable Late Shri Dadapatil Rajale who was also the founder of Vriddheshwar Sugar Factory which is situated at Adinathnagar. The college is situated at Adinathnagar, a small village in the Tehsil of Pathardi. The whole Pathardi region is continuously under the shadow of famine. There is scarcity of rain, which has added to the woes of the people of the region. Majority of the people of this region live below poverty line. Many of them are sugarcane cutters and poor peasants who remain outside the region to earn livelihood. There was no source of higher education in the nearby area for the children of such people. These people couldn't afford to send their children outside the region for seeking higher education; especially the girls were deprived of higher education. Considering their need, Honorable Late Shri Dadapatil Rajale decided to found the college in this region. His herculean effort was supported by a group of dedicated people who gave their valuable contribution in the establishment of this college. The following code of conducts are prepared for our college which are in accordance with the Professional Ethics laid down by UGC for the professionals.

- 5. Teacher should observe punctuality in teaching and other duties.
- 6. A teacher should refrain from harassment of student in any form and from any kind of discrimination
- 8. A teacher should actively participate in institutional development.
- 9. A teacher should inculcate human values, scientific outlook and concern for the environment among students and others.
- 10. A teacher should develop an understanding of our heritage.
- A teacher should encourage students to actively participate in scheme/ activities of national priorities.
- 12. A teacher should cooperate with the university authorities for betterment of the university.
- 13. A teacher should actively work for national integration and communal harmony.
- 14. A teacher should be sensitive to societal needs and development.

15. A teacher should abide by Act, Statutes, Ordinances, rules, policies, procedures of the university and respect its ideals, vision, mission, cultural practices and the traditions.

3. CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PHYSICAL DIRECTOR AND LIBRARIAN:

The Physical Director and Librarian should-

- 1. Adhere to a responsible pattern of conduct and demeanour expected of them by the community

- 8. Students should contribute towards cleanliness of the campus and surroundings.
- 9. All the students should respect and care for the institutional properties.
- 10. They must observe proper behaviour while on outside activities (educational tour/visit or excursion).
- 11. They should be honest in providing only truthful information on all documents.
- 12. They should maintain the highest standards of academic integrity while presenting own academic work.
- 13. They should help teachers in maintaining the learning environment conducive for all students.
