





Feedback on Syllabus (2020-2021)

The college was closed in early March 2020 due the COVID-19 pandemic and thereon the process of feedback on syllabus got affected in the academic year. However, the collected and analyzed feedback report is placed before the College Development Committee. The authority, considering an unprecedented pandemic situation, has suggested to adopt the following measures:

- a) Introducing the online classes using Google Meet application through which the faculty members engaged their classes.
